

Wilkinson County Commission
September 5, 2006

The Wilkinson County Board of Commissioners met in a Regular Session at 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, September 5, 2006 at the Wilkinson County Courthouse. The following Commissioners were present: C. L. Brooks Alfred Gibson, Dennis Holder, J.M. Howell. Commissioner John Williams was absent due to Board of Health meeting.

The following staff was present Senior Accounting Technician Judy Brown, Sheriff Richard Chatman and County Attorney Jon Helton. County Manager Laura Mathis was absent due to the death of her grandmother.

The following visitors were present: James Sheppard, Jonathan Jackson, Bob Brown, Teresa Bloodworth.

Chairman Holder called upon Commissioner Brooks to give the invocation.

I. Approval of Minutes.

Chairman Holder presented the minutes of the August 15, 2006 meeting. Copies of the minutes were distributed prior to the meeting. Upon motion of Commissioner Howell and second by Commissioner Brooks, the minutes were approved as prepared.

II. Recognition of Visitors

Chairman Holder recognized and welcomed all visitors to the meeting. Chairman Holder called upon Sheriff Chatman to address the Board. Sheriff Chatman presented a request to purchase radar for GSP Post 20. Upon motion by Commissioner Brooks and second by Commissioner Howell, the Wilkinson County Board of Commissioners unanimously approved the purchase from SPLOST 2003 Public Safety.

1. **Refund Request** A copy of the request for refund of 2004 and 2005 taxes from WKA was distributed prior to the meeting. Upon motion by Commissioner Howell and second by Commissioner Gibson, the Wilkinson County Board of Commissioners unanimously approved the request for a refund of the \$32,137.91 for tax year 2005 and to deny the request for a refund of the \$7943.84 for tax year 2004.

2. **Amendment to Intergovernmental Agreement on SPLSOT** Chairman Holder stated that Danville is requesting an amendment to the Intergovernmental Agreement to allow water and sewer purposes. Upon motion by Commissioner Brooks and second by Commissioner Howell, the Wilkinson County Board of Commissioners unanimously approved the amendment to the Intergovernmental Agreement on SPLOST 2003.

3. **Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy** A copy of the Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy was distributed prior to the meeting. Upon motion by Commissioner Brooks and second by Commissioner Gibson, the Wilkinson County Board of Commissioners unanimously approved the Comprehensive Economic Development Strategy.

V. Visitor Comments

Chairman Holder opened the floor to visitor comments. Chairman Holder called upon Teresa Bloodworth to address the Board regarding Davis Cemetery Road. Ms. Bloodworth discussed problems due to the hauling operations on the road and requested a stop sign on the haul road and possible changes to the entrance of the mine pit.

Chairman Holder called upon James Sheppard to address the Board regarding the placement of the Veteran's monument. After discussion, the Board of Commissioners agreed to walk around the property to identify possible locations for the monument.

Upon motion by Commissioner Brooks and second by Commissioner Gibson, the Wilkinson County Board of Commissioners voted to adjourn meeting.
