

Wilkinson County Commission
June 29, 2006

The Wilkinson County Board of Commissioners met in a Special Session at 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, June 29, 2006 at the Wilkinson County Courthouse. The following Commissioners were present: C. L. Brooks, Dennis Holder, J.M. Howell, John Williams. Commissioner Alfred Gibson was absent.

The following staff was present County Manager Laura Mathis, County Attorney Jon Helton. No visitors were present.

Chairman Holder called the meeting to order and stated the purpose of the special session was to discuss right of way acquisition, the closure of the courthouse for Independence Day Holiday and a personnel grievance.

I. New Business

1. **Right of Way Acquisition Chairman** Holder stated that Minor Drew McGahee, a property owner on Dent Road, is in support of the Dent Road project but due to restrictions on the land from his grandfather's will, he is unable to sign right of way deeds. Mr. McGahee is agreeable to have the right of way condemned by the Board subject to negotiations. Upon motion by Commissioner Brooks and second by Commissioner Howell, the Wilkinson County Board of Commissioners voted unanimously to condemn the right of way on Dent Road owned by Minor Drew McGahee.

2. **Independence Day** Upon motion by Commissioner Brooks and second by Commissioner Williams, the Wilkinson County Board of Commissioners unanimously approved that County offices be closed on July 3 and July 4 and that all full time employees receive holiday pay for both days.

3. **Personnel Grievance** Ms. Mathis presented a grievance filed by Renae Curry related to her termination. Upon review of the Personnel Policy, the Board of Commissioners determined that as a part time employee Ms. Curry does not have the right to appeal her termination and a letter should be sent indicating this.

Upon motion by Commissioner Brooks and second by Commissioner Williams, the Wilkinson County Board of Commissioners voted to adjourn meeting.
