

Wilkinson County Board of Commissioners  
January 29, 2007

The Wilkinson County Board of Commissioners met in a Special Session at 4:30 p.m. on Monday, January 29, 2007 at their office in the Courthouse. The following Commissioners were present: C. L. Brooks, Alfred Gibson, Dennis Holder, J.M. Howell and John Williams.

The following staff was present: County Manager Laura Mathis and Attorney Jon Helton on Hilbun and Helton. Visitors present: Jonathan Jackson.

Chairman Holder called upon Commissioner Williams to give the invocation.

Chairman Holder recognized and welcomed all visitors to the meeting.

**1. 2007 Beer and Wine License for Chocolate City** Upon motion by Commissioner Brooks and second by Commissioner Gibson, the Wilkinson County Board of Commissioners unanimously approved the Beer and Wine License for Ronald Williams at Chocolate City.

**2. Board Appointment to Wilkinson County Development Authority** Chairman Holder stated that the terms of several members of the Development Authority expire in February and May 2007. Upon motion by Commissioner Brooks and second by Commissioner Howell, the Wilkinson County Board of Commissioners approved the following appointments:

Bobby Green to a four year term to expire February 16, 2011

Roger Smith to a four year term to expire February 16, 2011

Bryan Sappe to a four year term to expire May 16, 2011

Phillip Hadarits to a four year term to expire May 16, 2011

**3. Board Appointment to Recreation Board** Upon motion by Commissioner Brooks second by Commissioner Williams, the Wilkinson County Board of Commissioners unanimously approved the appointment of Richard Taylor to fill the unexpired term of Renee Wilson on the Recreation Board.

**4. Community Development Block Grant** Chairman Holder stated that the food bank grant application would move forward with the proposed site of the property jointly owned by the City of Ivey and Wilkinson County.

**5. Condemnation of Right of Way on Oochee Creek** Ms. Mathis stated that the Etheridge property on Oochee Creek Road has sixteen owners and only four have executed deeds. The whereabouts of some of the remaining owners are unknown and others have not responded. Upon motion by Commissioner Howell and second by Commissioner Brooks, the Wilkinson County Board of Commissioners unanimously approved the condemnation of the Etheridge tract on Oochee Creek Road.

IV. Executive Session to Discuss Personnel Matter

Chairman Holder stated that the Board of Commissioners needed to discuss the Compensation of the Chief Appraiser. Upon motion by Commissioner Brooks and second by Commissioner Williams, the Wilkinson County Board of Commissioners unanimously approved entering executive session.

Upon motion by Commissioner Brooks and second by Commissioner Gibson, the Wilkinson County Board of Commissioners unanimously approved leaving executive session. Chairman Holder stated that no action was taken during the executive session.

Upon motion by Commissioner Brooks and second by Commissioner Williams, the Wilkinson County Board of Commissioners unanimously approved the salary of 21H for the new Chief Appraiser Amanda Panther.
