The meeting was called to order by Kelly Chatman @ 4:33pm. Mrs. Virginia Rozier prayed at the beginning of the meeting. Kelly Chatman read the minutes from the January meeting. The motion to create an Election Facebook page was presented by Kelly Chatman, Konreid Etheridge second the motion, everyone voted to carry this motion. No one opposed. We went through the paperwork and pointed out that the board is the superintendent, but we need to get each board member certified to be able to supervise an election if the supervisor or registrar is unable to supervise the election.
