The motion was made by Kelly Chatman @ 4:35 pm to start the meeting. The motion was seconded by Rev. James Smith. The meeting began with a prayer led by Rev. James Smith. The minutes were read & a motion was made to approve the minutes from the previous meeting with any necessary corrections by Kelly Chatman, the motion was seconded by Rev. James Smith to accept the minutes with any necessary corrections. The entire board approved the minutes & no corrections were needed. The next item of business was the raising of poll worker pay. The pay for each poll worker is as follows: Manager \$180, Asst. Manager \$150, Clerk \$100 & Office worker \$10/hour. This will be done by the 2024 election cycle. The motion to divide the High Hill precinct for the 2024 election cycle was made by Kelly Chatman; the motion was seconded by Rev. James Smith. The entire board voted yes to separate the High Hill precinct. The board discussed that we still need to get quotes for the rebuilding of the ramp at the new building. We will be reaching out to some more potential contractors for quotes. No one had any other business to bring to the table today. The motion was made by Kelly Chatman to adjourn the meeting @ 5:00 pm. The motion was seconded by Rev. James Smith & all voted in favor to adjourn the meeting.
